The program of the 13th edition of RemTech Expo opens with the first meeting of CHEMTECH's Technical Scientific Committee about innovative and sustainable industry!

"The circular economy starts from the design stages and is implemented through the use of technology and the commitment of all the parties involved", points out Marco Ravazzolo.

The day closes with ample satisfaction, aims for growth and launching immediate actions focused on expanding players to the comparison table in the logic of inclusion and sharing: focal characteristics of collective growth and industrial and social progress.
