**The programming of the 13th edition of RemTech Expo is enriched by new drivers linked to the protection of the territory from the hydrogeological risk and the management of the water resource. The experts talked about it at the ESONDA Scientific Technical Committee meeting!**

This year RemTech Expo is enriched by moments of wide sharing of knowledge, know-how, excellence and opportunities for growth and business and it does so through one of the historical segments of the event, **Esonda**.

On 6 February, at the headquarters of the Central Apennine Basin Authority, the Scientific Technical Committee of the Esonda thematic segment met, with the coordination of Eng. **Filippo Soccodato** (Alta Scuola) and the synergistic and active co-management of **Ing. Alessandro Trigila** (National Institute for Environmental Protection and Research), in the presence of some of the leading experts in the field.

Present at the table, representatives of the Institutions, the National Snpa System, Regions, Basin Authorities, Reclamation Consortia, Associations, National Councils of technical professionalism, the University and of course the major national private players connected to the world of works and infrastructure.

The Esonda program will introduce new elements this year with regard to the issues of **civil protection and prevention, land management and maintenance and the regulatory framework** of reference and there will be also moments of collegial comparison about **hydrogeological instability, hydraulic risk, climate change, management of water resources, planning and stability of the slopes** with a focus on design and construction of infrastructural works and networks.

There will also be good practices, narrated directly by the protagonists, the research projects, the technological innovations and the articulations that will be declined in the lighthouse conferences dedicated to the knowledge of the territory, the **General States of Geology** and the **General States of Engineering of the Territory** while the **National Conference of the University and Research** will be the occasion to direct the attention towards the study and research activities, the new professionals the representation of international success cases concerning the public and private sector.

The panel of activities is crowned by the Awards dedicated to Geomatics promoted by the National Council of Geometries the new special prizes in the inclusive and rewarding programming logic that aims to enhance and above all to replicate best practices.
