INERTIA 2020, REMTECH EXPO, THE NEWS OF NEXT EDITION

The agenda of the 14th edition of RemTech Expo is enriched by new and focal themes related to Circular Economy and sustainability of built contexts. The experts talked about that at the meeting of the Technical Scientific Committee of INERTIA.

On February 12th, at the headquarter of di Atecap Technical and Economic Association of concrete, the Technical Scientific Committee of Inertia met with the coordination of Dr. **Stefano Cicerani** supported by Dr. **Valeria Frittelloni** (Ispra).

The meeting was animated by some of the leading experts and representatives of the Institutions, Regions, Associations, Foundations, Universities, Research Centers and of course Companies operating in the reference contexts.

The most important innovations introduced this year by the program of edition 2020 of Inertia, concern Green New Deal, Circular Economy, Minimum Environmental Criteria CAM and built contexts.

Stefano Cicerani, scientific coordinator, announces the introduction of innovative conference formats through *"plenary events, thematic and training focus for all professionals and operators"*.

"At the meeting," continues **Valeria Frittelloni** of Ispra, *"we discussed in detail about the recent instructions introduced by Green Deal and new guidelines of European Commission. In this field, construction and the buildings system are evidently strategic with regard to the recycling of materials and their re-introduction into production circuits"*.

Edoardo Zanchini Vice-President of Legambiente strongly emphasizes *"we must accelerate, we must increase the use of materials from recycling rethink the specifications and invest in construction CAM. There are good practices and positive experiences, but numbers must increase. We will talk about that in the coming months and in Ferrara"*.

It is **Paola Ficco** of Reteambiente to add *"we talked about excavation soils and rocks, waste management, traceability, classification but also about rubble management, excavations and drilling with a new interpretation that starts from the construction site"*.

Marco Mari Vice-President of GBC Italy also confirms that *"Inertia will expand its field of action in the next edition, drawing a field of action that extends to the built contexts. Inertia also highlights the vocation of an event where the themes of the Circular Economy are discussed through an institutional and regulatory approach, through the presentation of case studies, the best innovations and the reporting tools required by the European Union and the market"*.

For **Antonella Luciano** of Enea, coordinator of ICESP Italian Circular Economy Stakeholder Platform, *"An important discussion took place today. We believe it is time to expand the context by exploring the entire supply chain of the built contexts in terms of Circular Economy."*



The second edition of the **INERTIA AWARDS** was confirm, finally. Last year was a great success in terms of participation and selected contributions and saw as winners, in the different categories, Calcestruzzi spa, San Colombano Costruzioni spa and the University of Salerno. The 2020 Call for Proposals will be open at the end of March.

The day closes with full satisfaction and with the launch of actions aimed to consolidate and expand the panel of technical, strategic and regulatory opportunities for all stakeholders involved.
