26 – 28 March 2020

EnergyMed, Mostra d' Oltremare, Naples and Giugliano

The Agreement between **RemTech Expo** (FerraraFiere) and **EnergyMed** (Mostra d'Oltremare of Naples) was signed yesterday, December 10, 2019, by **Filippo Parisini** President of FerraraFiere and **Michele Macaluso** AD of Anea, concerning an innovative and extraordinary project, Campania Technological Hub.

Campania Technological Hub project was born in March 2019 on the occasion of an important event organized in Giugliano on the subject of **Land Reclamation and Development**. The event was attended by Minister **Sergio Costa**, Undersecretary **Salvatore Micillo**, the President of Anac **Raffaele Cantone**, the Extraordinary Commissioner Gen. **Giuseppe Vadalà** and **Silvia Paparella**, General Manager of RemTech Expo, the permanent international event specialized in the themes of remediation, environmental and natural risks, regeneration and sustainable industry (23-25 September 2020, www.remtechexpo.com).

Campania Technological Hub is born in full synergy with the **Ministry of the Environment** and the Protection of the Territory and the Sea, **Ispra**, the **Extraordinary Commissioner** for the Remediation of Abusive Landfills, and with the participation of all the major, national and international, public and private players, with the aim of promoting the value of rehabilitation of the territory and environmental recovery in Campania.

The joint project provides for the organization of an important event centered on the theme of technologies and remediation activities, crowned by an exhibition of the best products and services and by moments of confrontation between institutions, companies, associations, universities, research, experts every day engaged in the regeneration of contaminated territories. It also provides for a moment of meeting and discussion with citizens and students of some schools in the area and site visits directly on the "**terra dei fuochi**".

The venues for the event are two, Naples, at the **EnergyMed** fair, one of the most important national events on sustainable development and renewable energy sources, from **26 to 28 March 2020**, at the Mostra d'Oltremare and **Giugliano** where a broad involvement of citizenship and especially of schools is expected.

Campania Technological Hub represents a real **pole of excellence** that sees, among others, the possibility of identifying pilot areas for the application of innovative technologies already available on the market and the testing of new technologies in the validation phase.

The occasion will also be propitious to illustrate the important winning methodological approaches, implemented nationally and internationally, including the **Taranto Model** developed by the Extraordinary Commissioner for urgent remediation, environmentalization and

redevelopment of Taranto and strategies for overcoming community infringements developed by the Extraordinary Commissioner for the Remediation of **Abusive Dumps**, as well as technological excellence for characterization and remediation carried out at national and international level.

In order to best frame the important objectives, it was decided to appoint a dedicated **Scientific Committee**, which will have the task of identifying the best congressional strategies and the methods for promoting the expected and achieved results.

The Scientific Committee will be coordinated by one of the leading international experts on the remediation of contaminated sites, Prof. **Vito Felice Uricchio** of the **National Research Council**.

The preliminary program sees, on Thursday 26 March, the **Campania Technology Hub National Conference: reclamation of contaminated sites, technological innovation, permanent public-private comparison**, while Friday 27 March will be the turn of the event on the **Contribution of scientific and administrative innovation towards the reform of the reclamation sector: technologies, innovation, scientific research and applied research, the phyto-assisted bioremediation**. For Saturday, March 28, a rich and articulated **Program of meetings and conferences with school students and with the citizens** of Giugliano and a site visit in the field of the "terra dei fuochi" is on the agenda.

From tomorrow, it will be possible to send applications for participation in the congressional phases through a specific **Call for Abstract** which will be divided into three sessions, with invitation-by-papers, selected contributions, and a new poster contest: I. Characterization of polluted sites; II. Remediation technologies of polluted sites (water and soil), III. Environmental legislation in the field of reclamation, towards the definition of the DL #risanambiente.

Among the important objectives, there is the sharing of what is expected to be the first **Carta di Napoli** on the remediation of contaminated sites.

The appointment for the presentation of Campania Technology Hub to the press is scheduled for January 2020, when the **Press Release Conference** will be organized.
