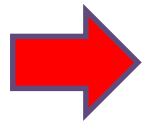
The Methodology

Identification of GPs - Categories



A 4 - Policy improvement tools and resources

4.1 Improvement of methodologies and tools for tracking and tracing waste generated by C&D. Collect the best practices from your territory.

A4.3 Participation in policy learning platforms.

Category 1

(IDENTIFICATION-SEPARATION-CHARACTERIZATION): this category includes good practices carried out mainly in the early stages of the works by construction / demolition companies.

Category 2

(TRANSPORT - TRACEABILITY - STORAGE): this category includes good practices mainly carried out by waste transport companies.

Category 3

(REUSE-RECYCLING-RECOVERY-QUALITY): this category includes good practices implemented by companies responsible for recycling or reusing construction and demolition processes, as well as companies responsible for ensuring the quality of these processes and products for their new uses.

Category 4

(POLICIES-AWARENESS): this category includes good practices mainly implemented by public administrations.



Transfer of GPs through Policy Instruments



50 GPs have been collected from the project partners in the 4 Categories described in a consolidated document named “A4.1 Best Practices”

The project partners will choose the GPs to transfer into their territorial policies through the 7 Policy Instruments identified in the project.

Each transfer process will be monitored through an Action Plan, approved by the Legal Representative of Each partner.

The transferability of GPs among partners requires a technical-economic feasibility and a Political consensus !

✓ **Technical-Economic Feasibility**

Through the cost-benefit Analysis of each individual experience provided by the project work through the activity named “A 4.2 Cost Benefit Analysis».

✓ **Political Consensus**

Through the policy briefs updating the territorial politics in the European sector policies and will contribute to transfer lessons learnt beyond the partnership
